

Saint Max Kolbe School's Scrip Tuition Credit Program Participant Agreement 2015– 2016

Your participation in the Saint Max Kolbe (SMK) Tuition Credit Program means you understand and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. SMK is not responsible for lost or stolen Scrip once placed in a child's backpack or picked up in the school front desk. We do not track individual Scrip serial numbers. Scrip is to be treated like cash. Protect it!
2. Extended family members and friends can participate in the Scrip Tuition Credit Program. Simply have them indicate on their Participant Agreement which family is to receive the tuition credits generated. Extended family members and friends cannot change their tuition credit designee each order period. Please choose one family for the entire academic year. Or, you can include their order with your family's order.
3. Scrip deadlines are strictly enforced. Due to short turn-around times, we cannot honor late orders. Orders and payments must be received in the school office or online through www.ShopWithScrip.com no later than 2:30 p.m. on the order date. Late orders will be processed during the next Scrip order period.
4. All Scrip orders are to be made using the Scrip Order Form or online at www.ShopWithScrip.com. Payments are to accompany all orders and checks are to be made payable to Saint Max Kolbe School. At this time, only check or cash payments are accepted. **Please note that Scrip is not tax deductible.**
5. Checks returned to SMS as Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF), will be represented to the bank after the participant is notified by telephone. Bank NSF fees will be charged to the participant.
6. Scrip tuition credits will be applied against your 2016-2017 tuition. Tuition credits are equal to 50% of the profit generated from your orders. Please review the order form for a list of vendors and their applicable profit or go to the Scrip page of the school website for a link to complete vendor information. Profit percentages change from time to time. We will do our best to communicate changes to you.
7. Participant families with their last student in Sixth Grade will have their Scrip credits applied to the General School Fund Account.
8. If a student/family leaves SMK during the academic year, tuition credits are forfeited and applied to the General School Fund Account.

Please sign the Scrip Participant Agreement, keep a copy for your records, and return the original to the school office.
